

The soprano from Granada Mariola Cantarero and the tenor from Jerez Ismael Jordi have shaped their careers with talent and effort, and have achieved success together and separately, enticing an audience overwhelmed by the beauty of their voices, their command of the stage and the passion and energy with which they represent each one of the roles they have performed.
